What services do we provide?

We are a private, statewide, nonprofit public interest law firm funded by grants from the Legal Services Corporation, the Nevada Law Foundation and District Court filing fees. We are dedicated to helping you. We provide legal services in civil matter to eligible clients. Eligibility depends on the type of legal assistance you need and your income level.

To be eligible for assistance through Nevada Legal Services you must be an individual, household, organization, group or Indian tribe with a low income.

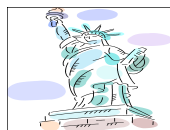

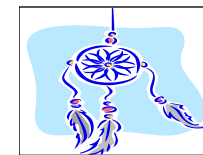
